### **Brief Nar-Anon History**

NAR-ANON was officially started by co-founder Alma B. in Christ Memorial Church in Studio City, California on November 11, 1960. This meeting was at the same time and location as the only Narcotics Anonymous meeting.

Alma, a former Al-Anon member, would check out the NA meeting for her husband, Bob B. After 6 months, Alma, along with another spouse of a NA member, adapted the Al-Anon program for themselves by changing the words "alcohol" to "drugs". However, the program failed to grow.


In 1968, Louise S., co-founder, started a Nar-Anon meeting on the Palos Verdes Peninsula, (greater Los Angeles area) with Margaret Z. Together and with a few other members, they traveled throughout the South Bay region of Los Angeles California starting meetings using the Nar-Anon Blue booklet which was the only piece of literature.

#### NaraScribes Bio
